## ANIMA makes press conference with special guest

The Society for the Protection of Animals - ANIMA held a conference today about the lack of animal welfare in Macau. The organization relies on the presence of Paul Littlefair, the highest representative of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (RSPCA), the largest organization in the UK who struggle for rescue, rehabilitation and adoption of animals.



Littlefair was invited by ANIMA, since it has been working with the Chinese authorities in drafting a law on animal protection. According to Albano Martins, president of the Animal Protection Society of Macau, the guest can come to help in drafting a similar law in the territory, something that's

much ANIMA tries to get there.

The conference takes place at the headquarters of ANIMA, in Altinho of Ka Ho, in Coloane, at 16h and its themes, in addition to sharing experiences of Paul Littlefair, Canidrome the current situation and the lack of legislation to protect animals from Macau. The RSPCA, which has as its patron the Queen of England, has over 200 years of existence and helped, only in 2011, more than 200,000 animals in the UK.
