


GREYHOUNDS BENEFIT FROM LEGISLATIVE PRESSURE

Since our formation in 2001...

 **Forty-four dog tracks, including multiple Florida tracks, have closed or ended live racing**

 **There are four tracks left in three states**

 **Greyhound racing is illegal in forty-one states**



Gambling on dog racing has decreased by over 76%

During this period, the rate of decline has **more than doubled**



WE HAVE PASSED EIGHTEEN MAJOR GREYHOUND PROTECTION LAWS

including dog track prohibitions in six states

2001 Passed a requirement in MA that all greyhound injuries be reported to the public. The measure also mandated reporting on the final disposition of all racing dogs.

2001 Passed the only state-funded greyhound adoption trust fund into law in MA.

2004 Passed a greyhound injury and disposition reporting law in NH.

2006 Repealed a longstanding \$325,000 annual subsidy for dog racing in NH.

2007 Repealed an annual subsidy for the drug testing of racing greyhounds in NH.

2008 Passed a statewide ballot initiative to prohibit greyhound racing in MA.

2008 Eliminated an exemption for racing greyhounds that existed under NH's state anti-cruelty laws.

2009 Passed a greyhound decoupling law in NH.

2010 Passed a law to prohibit greyhound racing in RI.

2010 Passed a law to prohibit greyhound racing in NH.

2012 Passed a greyhound decoupling law in AZ.

2012 Passed a law to prohibit greyhound racing in CO.

2014 Passed a greyhound decoupling law in IA.

2014 Passed a greyhound injury reporting law in AZ.

2016 Passed a law to prohibit greyhound racing in AZ.

2016 Passed a greyhound protection ordinance in Seminole County, FL.

2016 Passed a greyhound injury reporting requirement in FL.

2018 Passed a constitutional amendment to phase out dog racing in FL.
