

## CONTINUATION

The facts of the investigation are as follows:

Greyhound "TNT Quiet Riot" was housed at the Sanford-Orlando Kennel Compound and was supervised by the Trainer of Record Russell J. FORTUNATO.

On July 17, 2017, I spoke with trainer FORTUNATO at the Sanford-Orlando kennel compound. He stated that the greyhound had raced in the 15th race of the evening performance on July 13, 2017. He stated that during the race "TNT Quiet Riot" collided with another greyhound in the first turn causing "TNT Quiet Riot" to stumble and fall. FORTUNATO stated he took the greyhound to the track veterinarian Dr. Jerry SCHRADER, DVM (PMW 11357118). After his examination, Dr. SCHRADER determined the greyhound had fractured its cervical spine and it was determined there was nothing that could be done. The decision was made to euthanize the greyhound.

On July 17, 2017, I spoke with Dr. Jerry SCHRADER, DVM. He stated that the greyhound had fractured its cervical spine. He stated, because of this injury, he euthanized "TNT Quiet Riot" at the trainer's request (**EXHIBIT #2**).

PMW was notified within the specified time stated by Rule 61D-2.023 (3)(k).
