

CONTINUATION

An investigation into the facts revealed the following: Greyhound "PJ Bar Burry" was housed in Larson Kennels at the Sanford Orlando Kennel Club (SOKC) and is supervised by the Trainer of Record Eric **LARSON**.

On October 12, 2017, at 4:30 PM, at Sanford Orlando Kennel Club, I spoke with trainer **LARSON** in reference to this greyhound. **LARSON** stated that "PJ Bar Burry" was injured in a schooling race on October 7, 2017. During the race, the greyhound **collided with other greyhounds and sustained a neck injury**. After examination, track veterinarian, Dr. Jerry L. Schrader DVM (PMW 11357118 -19 / Vm14200-18) treated the greyhound. Dr. Schrader examined the greyhound every day through October 10, 2017 and the greyhound showed a few positive signs of a possible recovery. On the evening of October 10, Dr. Schrader was called to the kennel because "PJ Bar Burry" was in respiratory distress and the decision was made to euthanize the greyhound.

On October 14, 2017, at 1:00 PM, I spoke with Dr. Schrader. He advised that on the morning of October 7, 2017, during a schooling race "PJ Bar Burry" got tangled up with other greyhounds and rolled hard on the track. He stated that the greyhound's neck was injured during the tumbling and rolling. Dr. Schrader stated the greyhound was alert but was **paralyzed**. He stated that they decided to treat the greyhound with steroids for a few days to control swelling around a possible **cervical spinal cord/disc injury**. On October 10, 2017 at 6:45 PM, **LARSON** called for Dr. Schrader because the condition of the greyhound had worsened. Dr. Schrader stated he arrived at the kennel at 7:05 PM, and examined the greyhound. He stated the greyhound's condition was determined to be critical and the greyhound was **euthanized**. **(Exhibit # 2)**

It should be noted that on the vet report the greyhound's name is listed as "VJ Bar Burry", however the correct name is "PJ Bar Burry".

PMW was notified within the specified time stated by Rule 61D-2.023 (3)(k).

Case Status: Closed.
